AREG (<u>Aberdeen Renewable Energy Group</u>) is a partner in the ELBE (<u>European Leaders of Blue Energy</u>) consortium of seven Renewable Energy Cluster and is leading a trade mission to Canada that will be centred around the H2O Conference in Halifax.

In addition to attendance at the event, our wider agenda will include meetings and site visits with key industry stakeholders and prospective partners/clients for the European organisations that are participating. There is also a B2B facility for the conference that all companies in the ELBE delegation will be entitled to access free of charge.



The H2O – <u>Home to Overseas Conference</u> is organised by OTCNS alongside key government and industry partners, and is now one of Canada's premier events for the Ocean Technology sector with topics of particular relevance to ELBE including Ocean Energy, Blue Economy, and International Partnerships.

Atlantic Canada is home to a strong cluster of ocean industries and leading organisations such as <u>Marine Renewables Canada</u> and the <u>Ocean Supercluster</u> that are expected to become important partners for ELBE.

In the energy sector the region has a strong history in the development of tidal energy (being the location of the world's highest tides) and in more recent times has been positioning itself and the local supply chain to support wave and offshore wind projects.
